Deputy Ombudsman for the Visayas



Atty. Paul Elmer M. Clemente is a product of the public school system, having graduated from Butuan Central Elementary School for grade school; Philippine Science High School for secondary school; and, the University of the Philippines-Diliman Campus for his Bachelor of Science in Economics and Bachelor of Laws. He took and passed the 1993 Bar, and obtained eligibilities from the Career Service Executive Eligibility and Philippine Judicial Academy Prejudicature Programs in 2003.

He entered the Office of the Ombudsman in November 1995 as an Ombudsman Investigator, and left the Office in December 2006 as an Acting Assistant Ombudsman. In October 2012, he rejoined the Office as an Ombudsman Investigator and Prosecutor.

Prior to his appointment by the President to the post of Deputy Ombudsman for the Visayas, he was the Executive Officer of the Office of the Environmental Ombudsman and the Special Panel of Life Style Check Investigators of the Office of the Ombudsman.

He took his oath of office on 6 November 2014 before Ombudsman Conchita Carpio Morales.
