Re: Award for PB-2018-24

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) was created pursuant to Office Order No. 173 and Office Order No. 735 (Series of 2018), ensuring transparency in the procurement process and in the implementation of procurement contracts, with the end view of guaranteeing that contracts are awarded pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and that all procurement are conducted strictly according to specifications.

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2018, the Invitation to Bid for **PB 2018-24: Rebidding for the Supply, Delivery, Installation, Configuration, Migration and Testing of Disaster Recovery Infrastructure for the Office of the Ombudsman-Central Office and Recovery Site**, was posted at the PhilGEPS, Office of the Ombudsman Website, as well as in the Agency's Bulletin Board and published in the Manila Times a newspaper with national circulation.

WHEREAS, the total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for **PB 2018-24: Rebidding for the Supply, Delivery, Installation, Configuration, Migration and Testing of Disaster Recovery Infrastructure for the Office of the Ombudsman-Central Office and Recovery Site** is **Thirty Five Million Pesos (PhP35,000,000.00)**.

WHEREAS, for the period from September 19, 2018 to October 30, 2018, one (1) prospective bidder¹ bought the bid documents.

WHEREAS, a Pre-Bid Conference was conducted on October 05, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. with seven (7) prospective bidders² in attendance.

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2018, only one (1) bidder³ submitted their bids before the 1:30 p.m. deadline and simultaneously, the BAC conducted the opening of bids with the presence of the Technical Working Group (TWG), after evaluation of eligibility and technical components of Microbase Incorporated, the BAC declared the bidder as **"eligible"**. Thus Envelope No. 2 containing their financial proposals were opened, to wit:
