BAC Resolution No. 12-2019 (PB)
Series of 2019

Re: Award for PB-2019-08

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) was created pursuant to Office Order No. 219 (Series of 2019), ensuring transparency in the procurement process and in the implementation of procurement contracts, with the end view of guaranteeing that contracts are awarded pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and that all procurement are conducted strictly according to specifications.

WHEREAS, on 14 June 2019 the Invitation to Bid for **PB 2019-08: Public Bidding for the Supply and Delivery of Brand New Motor Vehicle Requirement (1 unit Mini Bus) of the Office of the Ombudsman**, was posted at PhilGEPS, Office of the Ombudsman Website, as well as in the Agency's Bulletin Board.

WHEREAS, the total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) **PB 2019-08: Public Bidding for the Supply and Delivery of Brand New Motor Vehicle Requirement (1 unit Mini Bus) of the Office of the Ombudsman** is **Three Million Seven Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php3,700,000.00)**.

WHEREAS, for the period from 14 June 2019 to 08 July 2019, three (3) prospective bidders¹ bought the bid documents.

WHEREAS, a Pre-Bid Conference was conducted on 24 June 2019 at 3:00 p.m. with two (2) prospective bidders² in attendance.

WHEREAS, on 08 July 2019³, three (3) bidders submitted their bid before the 1:30 p.m. deadline and simultaneously, the BAC conducted the opening of bids with the presence of the Technical Working Group (TWG), after evaluation of eligibility and technical components of **Areza Motor Sales and Prince Motor Corp.**, the BAC declared the bidders as "**eligible**", while **Durabuilt Motors Inc.**, was declared as "**ineligible**". Thus Envelope No. 2 containing the financial proposals of Areza Motor Sales and Prince Motor Corp., were opened, to wit:



WHEREAS, the TWG conducted the necessary post-qualification proceedings pursuant to Notice of Post Qualification issued by the BAC on 11 July 2019 to **Areza Motor Sales**, (having the Lowest Calculated Bid). After validation and verification⁴, the TWG determined that Areza Motor Sales complied with the OMB technical specifications and is responsive to all the legal requirements and conditions for eligibility.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby **RESOLVE** and **RECOMMEND** the **award of contract to Areza Motor Sales**, having submitted the **Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid** of **₱3,619,000.00**, subject to the posting of a bond to guarantee performance.


The dispositive portion reads as follows:


