BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE
RESOLUTION NO. AMP-11-110
AWARD FOR QN 2019-0117-OCT

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) was created pursuant to Office Order No. 219 (Series of 2019), ensuring transparency in the procurement process and in the implementation of procurement contracts, with the end view of guaranteeing that contracts awarded pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations, and that all procurement are conducted strictly according to specifications;

WHEREAS, there are approved **Purchase Request (PR) Nos. CO-19-01-102** and **CO-19-10-418** with a total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Three Million One Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (₱ 3,150,000.00)** for the **Negotiated Procurement for the Supply and Delivery of Brand New Motor Vehicles (AUV & Pick-Up) Requirement of the Office of the Ombudsman** for the use of **GAO and FIO II Proper**;

WHEREAS, said items are included in the **Annual Procurement Plan and Supplemental Project Procurement Management Plan for 2019 (APP Code: 2019APP153, 2019APP154 and 2019SPPMP099)**;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee was authorized to resort to Alternative Methods of Procurement in accordance with the provisions of **Section 53.1** of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 (**Two Failed Biddings**) under the same specifications for both lots but with adjusted ABC for Lot 1 – One unit Brand New Pick-Up per approved Technical Working Group (TWG) Memorandum dated **04 September 2019**;

WHEREAS, the BAC has undertaken the following activities:

- 1) Posted **Invitation to Bid** for **QN 2019-0117-OCT (1st negotiation)** at the PhilGEPS (Reference No. 6564930), Ombudsman Website and BAC Bulletin Board on **17 October 2019** and set the Negotiation Conference on **22 October 2019, 1:30 p.m.** and Deadline of Submission of Bids / Best and Final Offer on **28 October 2019, 1:30 p.m.**;
- 2) Issued **Supplemental / Bid Bulletin No. 1** dated **18 October 2019** for the **Amendments to the Bidding Documents**;
- 3) Requested quotations from **four (4)** suppliers of known qualifications;
 - a) ISUZU INTECO;
 - b) TOYOTA COMMONWEALTH;
 - c) TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC; and
 - d) ISUZU AUTOMOTIVE DEALERSHIP, INC. (ISUZU ALABANG)

- 4) Conducted a **Negotiation Conference** on **22 October 2019** with **two (2)** prospective bidders in attendance;
- 5) Received **two (2)** price quotations from the following suppliers before the 1:30 p.m. deadline on 28 October 2019:
 - a) ISUZU AUTOMOTIVE DEALERSHIP, INC.; and
 - b) TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC.

WHEREAS, the Opening of Bids was conducted on 28 October 2019, 1:30 p.m., wherein both bidders, **ISUZU AUTOMOTIVE DEALERSHIP, INC.** and **TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC.**, were declared as “Eligible” to proceed further in the next stage of Opening of Bids.

WHEREAS, upon evaluation of the contents of the Financial Envelope submitted by **ISUZU AUTOMOTIVE DEALERSHIP, INC.**, the TWG manifested that there was no SCHEDULE OF PRICES attached in its Amended Ombudsman Bid Form No. 2A. Since the said Schedule of Prices is an integral part of Amended Ombudsman Bid Form No. 2A, the TWG recommended that its Financial Bid be declared as “**FAILED**”. The BAC ruled to approve the recommendation of the TWG for the **Failure of ISUZU AUTOMOTIVE DEALERSHIP, INC. to submit the Schedule of Prices as required in the Invitation to Bid.**

WHEREAS, the BAC verbally notified the representatives of Isuzu Automotive Dealership, Inc. that they have three (3) calendar days within which to file a Request for Reconsideration on the said ruling. The representatives signified their intent to file the same, thus, the BAC ordered to reseal the submitted envelopes and were turned-over to the BAC Secretariat for safe-keeping.

WHEREAS, the BAC then ordered the opening of the financial component of the next bidder, **TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC.** and revealed the following, to wit:

WHEREAS, Isuzu Automotive Dealership, Inc. failed to file a Request for Reconsideration within the reglementary period.

WHEREAS, the TWG conducted the necessary post-qualification proceedings pursuant to Notice of Post Qualification issued by the BAC on 06 November 2019 to **TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC.** After validation and verification, the TWG determined that **TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC.** had complied with all the requirements provided by law and had passed all the criteria for Post Qualification.

WHEREAS, the BAC, upon recommendation from the TWG and upon due deliberation of the submitted bid, found the offer of **TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC.** as the Single Calculated Bid detailed as follows:




